Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Across England and Wales, any early brightness will give way to cloudy skies with outbreaks of rain in western regions gradually pushing eastwards. Clearer, showery weather is set to follow to northern England and Wales.

Meanwhile eastern Scotland may start dry. Otherwise Scotland and Northern Ireland can expect rain to turn heavy at times before replaced by clearer, showery weather, these turning wintry on hills and in the far north.

All regions will be windy at times with gales in western and northern regions. Temperatures should be near normal before Scotland turns colder.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Staying unsettled and very windy at times.
