Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many places will start grey today, but brighter weather in the west will spread to most parts by afternoon. Warm, especially in the west, but not quite so warm where any cloud lingers in central and eastern parts. Gentle winds with sea-breezes developing. Chilly tonight with low cloud creeping back westwards.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Low cloud and mist will once again burn back to the east coast on Friday with most parts then enjoying another dry and bright day with light winds. On Saturday, some coasts could have a little more cloud but the bulk of the country will be warm and sunny.
