Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a cold start with patchy frost and ice it will be a more settled day than yesterday. There will be variable cloud and sunny spells with wintry showers becoming confined to the east/northeast. Rain will move into England and Wales overnight with snow over high ground and possibly to lower levels at times.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Rain, sleet and hill snow across central areas will slowly ease and sink southwards on Friday. There will be sunny spells to the north and south with some showers, wintry at times. Less unsettled and remaining cold with sunny spells and scattered wintry showers on Saturday.
