

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 28 Sep 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Patchy fog in the south clearing to leave another largely dry day, with cloud breaking to sunny intervals in the afternoon. Cloudy in the northwest with occasional rain. Warm in the south. Patchy rain continuing in the northwest overnight. Elsewhere, light winds and variable cloud will allow extensive fog patches to develop across southern and central parts.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Generally dry with variable cloud and sunny spells Monday. A risk of showery rain moving northeast across southeast England with isolated heavy, possibly thundery, showers further west later. Windy at times in the northwest Tuesday, with occasional rain. Drier with sunny periods elsewhere.
