Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
England, Wales and eastern Scotland, generally dry and bright, hazy
sunny spells but patchy light rain affecting western and later
central parts. Northern Ireland and the rest of Scotland, wet with
rain, heavy at times. Generally windy, southerly gales in the
northwest and near Irish Sea coasts. Temperatures, near normal.

Overnight, rain will extend eastwards, some heavy in the north, but
light and patchy further south, some southeastern parts staying dry.
A few showers following, heavy and thundery in the northwest.
Staying quite windy.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Mainly dry, warm sunny spells but heavy, thundery showers in the
north and west at times.
