Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Tuesday, for most, will stay cloudy and dull with a few spells of rain or
drizzle around, especially towards southeast England with the odd moderate burst
possible. However, some brighter spells are likely around northwest Scotland,
western Wales and perhaps Cornwall later. Winds will generally be light and east
or southeasterly.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Persistent rain and gusty southerly winds will edge-in from the west to affect
far western parts of the UK during Wednesday, this including Northern Ireland,
and lingering here into Thursday with some heavy bursts at times. Elsewhere,
mild and mostly dry with variable cloud and a few brighter spells.
