

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 10 May 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunshine and showers for most, with the showers mainly in western parts, whilst the southeast stays largely dry. This comes after a spell of more general rain moving through Scotland, parts of Wales and northern England during the morning. Overnight, the showers should gradually die away, although a band of showery rain will move eastwards through northern and western parts.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Becoming generally cooler. Rather cloudy with brisk winds at times in northwestern UK, with the bulk of rain or showers over the two days falling here. Drier and often brighter towards the southeast, although a few heavy showers remaining possible.
