#### General Situation

A large area of low pressure in the Atlantic will maintain a very mild, moist, strong and unsettled southerly or southwesterly airflow for the next couple of days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, veering southwest 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough in north.

Rain then showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or very poor, becoming mainly good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest for a time, 5 to 7, decreasing 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast veering southwest for a time, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, fog patches at first, becoming fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good for a time.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest for a time, 4 or 5.

Slight occasionally moderate.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering southwest for a time, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, fog patches at first, becoming fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good for a time.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly veering southwesterly for a time, 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Occasional rain, fog patches at first, becoming fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good for a time.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate for a time.

Occasional rain, fog patches at first, becoming fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good for a time.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing southeast for a time, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain, fog patches at first, becoming fair for a time.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good for a time.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing southeast for a time, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later, decreasing 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough later.

Occasional rain, becoming fair for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.

Slight in east, otherwise moderate or rough.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing southeast for a time, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 or severe gale 9 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough later.  
Occasional rain, becoming fair for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 to 7, veering southwest 4 or 5 for a time.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing southeast for a time, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 or severe gale 9, perhaps storm 10 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough or high later.  
Occasional rain, becoming fair for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering southwest for a time, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Slight becoming moderate or rough later.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest becoming cyclonic later, 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.  
Moderate or rough, decreasing slight at times.  
Occasional rain, fog patches at first, becoming fair for a time.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good for a time.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast veering southwest for a time, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4, then increasing 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain at times.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest veering west or southwest for a time, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time.  
Mainly moderate.  
Rain at first, then again later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest becoming cyclonic later, 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough, decreasing slight at times.  
Occasional rain, becoming fair for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly becoming cyclonic later, 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough, decreasing slight at times.  
Occasional rain, becoming fair for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South veering southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, becoming variable 4 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.  
Rain early and later, otherwise showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.  
Smooth at first in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in south.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast, veering southwest, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough in far north and in far south.  
Rain early and late, otherwise showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough later.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast, veering southwest, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.  
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.  
Rain early and late, otherwise showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Thursday 05 Nov 2015 at 1200 UTC until Friday 06 Nov 2015 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Atlantic low complex extends troughs over Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate.  
Occasional rain with fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Friday 06 Nov until 1200 UTC on Friday 06 Nov:

Southeast 5 or 6, veering south for a time.  
Moderate.  
Occasional rain with fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 6 to 7 veering southwest and decreasing 5 to 6 this evening, decreasing 4 to 5 for a time overnight and backing southerly, veering southwest 6 to 7 Friday morning.

Moderate to rather rough, perhaps locally rough mid-channel this afternoon.

Occasional rain and drizzle, clearing for a time overnight.

Moderate to poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 to 7, decreasing 5 to 6 in the afternoon, then 2 to 4 for a time in the evening and backing southerly, increasing 4 to 6 by Saturday morning.

Moderate in the south to rough in the north, with an increasing swell, becoming slight to moderate later.

Occasional rain and drizzle, clearing for a time in the evening.

Moderate to poor.

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
