Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain, heavy at times, affects many parts of the United Kingdom this morning. It should ease during the afternoon and evening as drier and clearer conditions spread from the north although outbreaks of rain may continue in some southern and western parts overnight. Wintry showers continue in northern and eastern Scotland throughout.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain spreads northeastwards during Wednesday, turning to sleet and snow in parts of central and northern England and southern Scotland. Remaining changeable on Thursday with some outbreaks of rain but also some drier and brighter periods, the best of these in the north. Becoming windy in the west.
