Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Scotland and Northern Ireland will have bright or sunny spells although there will be large areas of cloud and showers, some heavy and thundery. England and Wales, after a rather cloudy, showery start in the southeast, a mixture of bright or sunny spells and heavy, thundery showers is in store. Generally rather warm or warm in sunnier areas.

Tonight, many northern and western parts will stay cloudy with heavy, thundery rain or showers. Further east, it should become mainly dry with patchy mist.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Further thundery showers for many on Tuesday but northern parts should be drier and brighter on Wednesday.
