Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Lincolnshire, East Anglia and southeast England should stay dry today with patchy fog lifting and hazy sunshine coming through. In the rest of England, Wales and most of Scotland, once any fog has disappeared, a little sunshine should develop before rain arrives with clearer, showery weather following towards the west.
However Shetland will stay mainly dull and damp, while in Northern Ireland, rain arriving this morning will give way to brighter skies this afternoon with showers following.
Tonight, rain will continue eastwards and followed by clearer, showery weather.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Blustery showers on Saturday, but very wet with some gales on Sunday.
