

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be a cloudy day across southwestern parts, with occasional rain and hill snow, and further wintry showers will also spread across northern and eastern coasts. Elsewhere it will be dry and cold, with some sunshine. Overnight, rain and hill snow will continue in the southwest and also spread across Scotland, but otherwise it will be dry and frosty.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
It will be rather cold and unsettled with outbreaks of rain, sleet and hill snow affecting many areas. However some sunny spells are likely, particularly in the south. Also, southwesterly winds will be brisk at times, particularly across northern parts.
