Headline:

Sunny spells, heavy thundery showers. The south becoming drier tonight.

Today:

Brighter or sunny spells and occasional showers, heavy and prolonged in places with the risk of localised thundery downpours especially in central and eastern parts.

Tonight:

The south and east will become largely dry. Showers with some longer spells of rain spreading from the west into some central areas.

Outlook for Saturday:

Sunshine and scattered showers in south. Showers more frequent in the north.
