Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Starting crisp and cold, with a widespread frost and with some ice patches likely where showers have fallen overnight, chiefly in the northwest. Most will stay dry throughout Saturday with plenty of sunny spells, however, far western parts will be a little cloudier at times with a few showers, these most frequent and wintry in the far northwest.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain or showers will affect most at times on Sunday, before this more unsettled weather generally clears eastwards to give a generally drier and brighter Monday. Becoming generally windy late on Monday, especially in the west and south of the UK.
