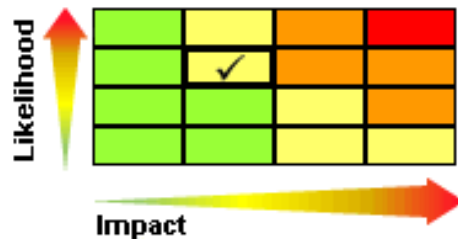
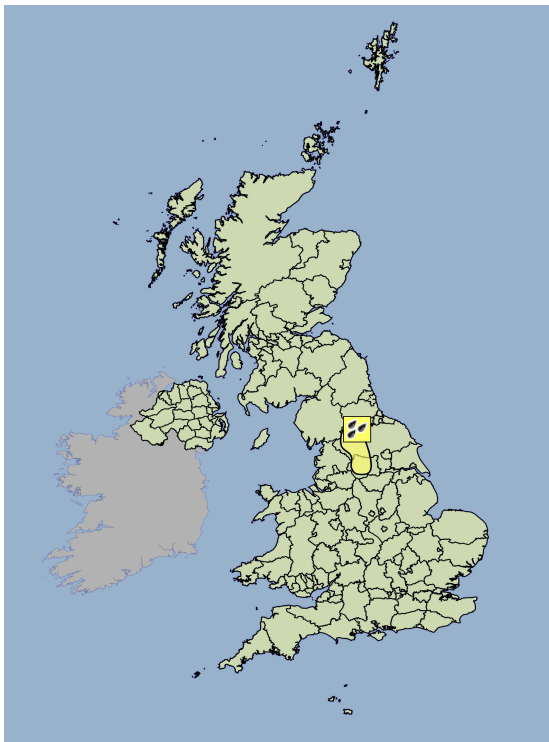


National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Outbreaks of rain, heavy at times, reaching southwestern England on Tuesday morning will move fairly quickly northeastwards across England, Wales and Northern Ireland to lie over a large part of Scotland by Tuesday evening. This rain is likely to last approximately 4 or 5 hours in any one place.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **16:00 on Tue, 15th Dec 2015** until **21:00 on Tue, 15th Dec 2015**

Outbreaks of rain will affect the region within the yellow warning area for a few hours during the very late afternoon and evening on Tuesday. Whilst rainfall totals are not expected to be particularly high, in view of current ground conditions please be aware of the possibility of some localised flooding.
