Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A fragmenting band of rain and drizzle in western Britain will continue extending southeastwards during the day, but with very little left on it by the time it reaches southeast England. Here it should remain dry. Showers will follow into Scotland. Elsewhere, some bright or sunny intervals, but for many staying largely overcast.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain in southern Britain on Wednesday will intensify as it crosses the southeast. It will be brighter with sunshine and showers in northern Britain. On Thursday, more straightforward with sunshine and showers, the showers heaviest in the north and east.
