


**Yellow warning  
Rain**



**Heavy rain followed by showers likely to lead to some flooding and disruption to travel.****What to expect**

- Flooding of a few homes and businesses is likely
- Bus and train services probably affected with journey times taking longer
- Spray and flooding on roads probably making journey times longer

**Further details**

A band of rain will arrive in the far south-west of England later on Sunday afternoon, moving north-east into the evening, bringing 10-15 mm of rain widely and possibly 25 mm over high ground. This will be followed by heavy showers overnight and at first on Monday morning, which could produce 10-15 mm of rain in less than 2 hours in places.
