Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
A cloudy start across much of Scotland, Northern Ireland, northern England and north Wales with outbreaks of rain, heavy and persistent in places. Southern areas will be mainly dry and bright, with some hazy sunshine making it feel warm, although patchy rain is likely across parts of the Midlands and East Anglia later. Many northern areas should become dry during the afternoon, perhaps with some brighter spells.

Patchy rain affecting some southern and southeastern parts overnight, mostly dying away later. Generally cloudy elsewhere, but mainly dry.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Mainly dry with some warm sunny spells developing. Patchy rain affecting some northwestern areas.
