Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A largely cloudy day with patchy light rain and drizzle in most places. A band of heavier rain is likely to affect many southern counties through the day. Windy and cold in the north, with an increasing risk of rain turning to snow across the Scottish mountains. Milder elsewhere with lighter winds.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain will affect many central areas through Saturday, with snow falling to increasingly lower levels, but Scotland and some southern areas perhaps staying brighter. Rain will clear south across all areas during Sunday but turning to snow in places as much colder weather develops across the whole country.
