

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southern UK will start dry with warm sunny spells, although some eastern coastal areas should see some early mist and low cloud. Northern UK will also be cloudier, with patchy rain giving way to scattered showers later on, but also some brighter intervals. It will be dry and cool overnight for most, although Northern Ireland may see patchy rain later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Mainly dry and fine on Sunday, with a brighter start in eastern coastal districts compared to Saturday. Northwestern UK will become increasingly cloudy however, with patchy rain following later. Monday will be similar, with the west likely to be warmest.
