

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 28 Nov 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Northern Scotland should have a largely dry morning, but rain arriving later.  
Otherwise rain over southwest Scotland, Northern Ireland and parts of northwest  
England moving southeast across most other parts during the day, heavy at first.  
Some drier, brighter weather will follow, but with rain returning to Northern  
Ireland later. Heavy rain in southern areas tonight. Staying mild.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain in the south at first will clear southeastwards leaving plenty of dry  
weather with sunny spells, but with showers in the north and northeast. Largely  
cloudy on Friday with outbreaks of rain, heavy at times. Becoming showery and  
windy thereafter.
