Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Southernmost counties of England should have a bright start, otherwise mostly cloudy for bank holiday Monday. Outbreaks of rain in many northern and central parts through the day, with some heavy and persistent rain likely over northwestern hills. Southern parts of England should stay mostly dry however, just the odd spot of rain possible. A windy day in the north.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Further rain is likely at times over northern and western areas where it will often be quite windy. The best of the sunshine over southeastern parts of England and staying mostly dry here. Temperatures near or below the seasonal average.
