Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Monday 05 December to 0600 UTC Tuesday 06 December 2011

#### General Situation

Low pressure to the north of Scotland and high pressure near the Azores will maintain a run of cool showery winds across the British Isles. Small, but intense low pressure systems moving southeastwards in the flow may bring severe gales or storm force winds to northeast Scotland on Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming west or northwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 later in north.

Moderate or rough in east, very rough or high in north.

Squally wintry showers, snow possible later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 6 to gale 8, increasing severe gale 9 or storm 10 for a time, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in east, very rough or high in north.

Squally wintry showers, perhaps snow for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 4 in north at first, otherwise westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 later near Rattray Head.

Moderate or rough.

Wintry showers, snow possible later in north.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first near Rattray Head, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, but very rough for a time near Rattray Head.

Squally wintry showers, perhaps snow for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Squally wintry showers at first, becoming fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Squally wintry showers, snow later.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4 at first in north, otherwise westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times in far south and later in far north.

Squally wintry showers, then snow, becoming mainly fair later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north, backing southerly 3 or 4 for a time, veering west 7 to severe gale 9 later.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far north and far south.  
Squally wintry showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4 at first in north, otherwise westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in far south, increasing gale 8 or severe gale 9 later in far north.  
Very rough or high.  
Squally wintry showers, then snow, becoming mainly fair later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 or severe gale 9, backing southeasterly 3 or 4 for a time.  
Rough or very rough, occasionally high in far north and far south.  
Squally wintry showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A polar low will move east between Orkney and Shetland this afternoon and evening and another southeast across Shetland during Tuesday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Gale force 8 backing westerly and increasing severe gale force 9 later, issued 2145 on Sunday.

Northwesterly 5 to 7 backing westerly then becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in east.

Wintry showers, some heavy and prolonged.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 05 Dec until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 06 Dec:

Cyclonic 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times, occasionally gale 8 in south later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in east.

Wintry showers, some heavy and prolonged.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 6 to 7 with some gusts to 45kt, backing northwest to west by afternoon.

Rough, locally very rough.

Scattered squally rain or hail showers.

Moderate to good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest to west 5 to 7 with gusts to 40kt.
