Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Risk of icy patches on roads at first in northern and western areas. Wintry showers over Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England will clear, then most areas dry and bright. Further sleet or snow will spread to northern Scotland. Many other areas dry and frosty. Cloud will increase later in the west with some rain by dawn.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday, rain with snow over central Scotland, then drier further north. Heavy rain and strong winds will spread to England and Wales. Rain at first in the east will clear on Tuesday morning, then mainly dry and bright, but further rain later.
