Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A bitterly cold day everywhere with heavy snow clearing from southern England.
Further snow flurries are likely almost anywhere but particularly near eastern
coasts and Northern Scotland. Western parts of the UK will see the best of the
sunshine but it will be bitterly cold with a strong northeasterly wind.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Some snow is likely to eastern and central parts of England as well as the east
coast of Scotland on Thursday. Elsewhere will be dry and sunny but again
bitterly cold. By Friday some more general heavy snow is likely for eastern
England with other parts very cold and sunny.
