

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Very warm with sunshine in the south. Dry in northern Scotland. Cloudier across northern England, southern Scotland and northwest Wales, with rain developing. The risk of isolated, heavy, showers in central areas later. Mostly dry overnight and humid in the south with some fog patches. Scattered, heavy showers in central areas this evening, with further rain in western Scotland tonight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Warm with sunny interludes, but also showers in places on Friday, perhaps heavy in the southeast later. Southwest England, the Midlands and much of Wales likely to stay dry. Sunny spells on Saturday, but feeling noticeably cooler, with occasional showers.
