Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
South and southwest England and Wales will be generally cloudy with intermittent rain, although the rain should become more sporadic through the day. Northeast Scotland is also likely to see outbreaks of rain. Elsewhere, mainly dry and bright with some sunshine. Patchy mist or fog is possible around southern coasts, and also inland at first.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rather cloudy in southeastern areas on Thursday morning. Elsewhere, and throughout Friday, most places should be fine and dry with sunny spells. Becoming warm, locally very warm, across much of the country, but also often feeling humid. Areas of fog persisting around some coasts.
