

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Today the eastern side of England and Scotland will have rain, occasionally turning to sleet and snow in places, especially on hills, although strong winds will gradually ease. Further west, drier and brighter, although there will be some showers around and these will be wintry at times. Little change tonight, although frost and fog will form locally.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

On Sunday rain and snow will gradually become confined to eastern Scotland. Elsewhere, icy patches and fog patches will gradually clear to leave sunshine and a few wintry showers. Monday, some frost and fog patches at first but many areas dry and bright.
