Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A windy day in the north with showers across northwestern parts soon becoming replaced by more persistent rain. Elsewhere, after a chilly start it will be a mostly dry and bright day for many, but cloud amounts steadily increasing from the west. Remaining wet and windy in the northwest overnight. Otherwise, a mostly dry, mild and rather cloudy night.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Strong winds and occasional rain in northwestern areas will ease on Friday, leaving most parts dry but rather cloudy by the weekend, with eastern areas seeing the best of any brightness. Generally mild and frost-free for the vast majority throughout.
