Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Strong winds are expected with gales developing later today and tonight and damaging storm force winds, especially in parts of England and Scotland.

Today, most areas will have sunny intervals and squally showers, particularly more western and northern regions with most of these falling as rain on lower ground, although in Scotland, increasingly turning to snow. Tonight, more squally showers of rain, sleet or snow are expected and everywhere feeling cold, especially the north.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

On Sunday, very strong winds will gradually ease with wintry showers mostly clearing away, while Monday brings sunshine to the south and some rain further north.
