

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 26 Feb 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers or more persistent rain will affect most today, with heavy, possibly
thundery, bursts at times. More persistent rain should become confined to parts
of eastern England during the afternoon. Drier and clearer, although sometimes
breezy conditions should spread across the rest of the UK by evening, with a
touch of frost in sheltered rural spots.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Scattered heavy showers are expected on Sunday. Drier weather should spread into
the north and west later, persisting through Monday. In the southeast, however,
cloud and rain will push in late on Sunday, remaining cloudy with light showers
through Monday. Windy in the southwest.
