Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places dry and sunny, but parts of northeast Scotland and some English east coasts will be cloudier, with possible light rain in East Anglia and Shetlands. Cloudier too in Northern Ireland, West Wales and Cornwall. Overnight, cloudy with light drizzly rain in parts of northeast Scotland, West Wales and Southwest England, otherwise dry and largely clear. Winds mainly light.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday, bright or sunny in east. Cloud, mist and light rain and drizzle in the west will spread erratically eastwards through the day. Generally cloudy and misty on Tuesday with patchy rain. Some brighter spells developing from the northwest.
