Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Rain persisting in England and Wales until afternoon, then clearing  
all but southern England and East Anglia, with sunny intervals and  
decreasing winds. Rain moving quickly north across Scotland and  
Northern Ireland, becoming squally as severe gales develop, easing  
later in Northern Ireland. Mild, perhaps exceptionally mild in south  
and east for a time, feeling colder in north later.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

On Wednesday, rain in south spreading north, becoming showery later  
to north of Wales. Gales in far north at first and in southwest  
later. Rain persisting in South Wales and southern England on  
Thursday, with showers and sunny intervals in north.
