Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Some frost and fog is expected initially across northern and western parts of the UK. Otherwise, most parts should have a fine, dry and sunny, but rather cold, day, although showers are likely over northernmost Scotland and perhaps down the east coast England.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Rain will gradually spread south over Scotland and N.Ireland during Sunday. Elsewhere will have a very cold start with some fog, but should then be fine and sunny. However, fog patches may persist all day in some sheltered spots. Rain will push south across the rest of the UK during Monday with colder, more showery conditions following.
