

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will continue over Scotland with snowfalls on high ground, the rain spreading to Northern Ireland during the day. Elsewhere, most will start the day dry, cold and frosty, with sunny spells and showers following, these occasionally heavy and thundery, but generally clearing by evening.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

There will be rain at times in northern areas on Wednesday, becoming heavier in the northwest, with hill snow in Scotland. Elsewhere, a dry, sunny start is expected then showers will develop, locally heavy, clearing in the evening. Further rain is likely on Thursday, clearing eastward, followed by locally heavy and thundery showers.
