Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Patchy rain over parts of Northern England and the far Northwest of Wales, will spread north again later, and in may turn heavier by evening over Cumbria. Elsewhere apart from a few showers in NW Scotland, dry and fine with some bright spells. Warmest and sunniest in the southeast where temperatures could reach 28C.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Wet at first over much of Scotland and N.Ireland, with some heavy rain at first, and this rain will spread to western fringes of England and Wales later. Elsewhere dry and warm with some sunshine. The warmest day of the year is possible in the southeast.
