Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cloudy and dull day for all bar parts of northern Scotland and Northern Ireland. There will be light rain at times for many, with some snow on northern hills for a time. Later, in the far southwest, the rain may turn heavy before clearing away in the evening. Northern Ireland should have a brighter day with a few showers.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

On Tuesday, mainly dry with occasional cloud breaks in the east, but rain in the west will become heavy. Wednesday sees more rain in Northern Ireland and the far northwest but elsewhere it should be breezy, mild, and mainly dry.
