Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A fine day for most with plenty of warm sunny spells once any early mist or fog patches clear. It will stay dry with clear spells overnight, allowing it to turn chilly with isolated patches of mist or fog developing once again. However, it will be cloudier at times in the far northwest of Scotland, with patchy rain possible.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

The fine spell of weather will continue into Wednesday and Thursday. It will feel warm by day with plenty of sunny spells and light winds, but chilly by night with some isolated mist or fog patches developing in the clear spells.
