

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 25 May 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Generally rather cloudy but southeastern parts of the UK should have some warm hazy sunshine. Outbreaks of rain will spread across northern and western areas during the day, with strong winds too. Overnight, this occasional rain will make very gradual progress eastwards but the far southeast of England will remain dry, and it will be a milder night than recently.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A showery day for most of the UK on Thursday, showers heavy in places, but some sunny intervals in-between. Drier weather will spread from the west later and last into Friday, which will be much cooler with brisk northwesterly winds.
