Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
A showery start in many places, particularly Scotland, where showers will fall as snow, with drifting in gale force winds. Showers easing in the west as the wind decreases, but strong to gale force winds and blustery showers continuing in the east. Drier and sunnier in places sheltered from north. Feeling very cold everywhere.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

On Monday, early widespread frost and patchy fog in England and Wales. More cloudy and becoming less cold in Scotland and Northern Ireland, with outbreaks of rain. On Tuesday, windy with rain or drizzle in Scotland and Northern Ireland. England and Wales bright spells, rather cold.
