Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
After a foggy start in places, it should gradually brighten up across England and Wales. A band of heavy showery rain across northern areas will push south through the day, introducing windier and colder weather with sunshine and wintry showers. It will become dry overnight with ice in places before rain reaches the west by dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
It will turn wet and windy across all areas on Sunday with showers following across England and Wales and more persistent rain and snow continuing across the northwest. Colder weather follows on Monday with rain or showers that may turn to snow in places.
