

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will spread southeastwards across the UK today, with snow falling on hills in the north, then at all levels in central, southern and eastern parts of England this afternoon and evening. Snow will linger in the southeast overnight but most other areas will become dry and cold with icy patches, low cloud and fog forming in places.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Any snow in the southeast will die out on Sunday morning. Eastern parts of the UK will then remaining largely dry but cold. Western areas will see outbreaks of rain on Sunday and Monday though, but will feel less cold.
