Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sunny spells and scattered showers for central and northern parts this morning, with showers persisting in Scotland this afternoon. However, breezy conditions with cloud and rain across southern parts will become more widespread through the day, with some heavy rain. That rain will push northwards across Scotland tonight, with other parts clearing to dry spells and showers.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Cloudy with further outbreaks of rain over southern England and also much of Scotland tomorrow. Brighter with occasional sunny spells and scattered showers elsewhere. Largely showery on Friday with spells of rain in places too. Generally breezy with temperatures around normal.
