Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Eastern areas will have a cold start with fog in places. It will be wet further west with wind and locally heavy rain spreading to all parts through the day, accompanied by extensive hill fog. The rain will clear all but the far southeast overnight with drier conditions following before strong winds and heavy showery rain push across northwestern areas.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Southern areas will have a dry morning on Saturday before heavy rain across northern parts pushes south through the afternoon. Colder, windier and showery weather will follow with showers becoming increasingly wintry. Wet and windy across all areas on Sunday.
