Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
There will be further snow showers across eastern England, some of which will be heavy at first in the southeast, although the showers will tend to ease as the day goes on. Patchy rain and sleet across northern Scotland will edge slowly southwards into northeastern England, but elsewhere it will be dry and cold with sunny spells.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday an area of chiefly light rain and snow will edge southwards across England and Wales, with drier, brighter conditions following from the north. On Saturday there will be isolated wintry showers, although most places will be dry and bright throughout.
