

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cold and breezy with some sunshine, the chilly northwesterly winds persisting. Generally dry although a few showers will continue near windward coasts especially in the far north. Turning cloudier later in the north with rain spreading to the west and far north of Scotland. Tonight, mainly dry but increasingly cloudy in the south, northern areas cloudy with rain at times.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Southern and western areas mainly dry but rather cloudy at times. Northern and eastern parts cloudy with rain at times especially in the northwest. On Sunday, showers spreading south for a time, followed once more by cooler and brighter weather.
