

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Fine with sunny spells for many, but scattered showers near western, northern and eastern coasts. The showers heaviest and most frequent in the northeast, wintry over the hills. Chilly, especially in strong winds in the east with coastal gales likely. Another cold night with a local frost, away from the winds in the north and east.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Strong winds and scattered showers in the east on Sunday, extending further inland, again wintry over hills. Drier and brighter elsewhere, but frequent showers over Pembrokeshire and Cornwall. Staying cold with overnight frosts. Winds easing on Monday with showers easing from the west too.
