

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 21 Oct 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mist and fog across England and Wales will clear during the morning to reveal another dry day with sunny periods. The sunshine will become hazy later as high cloud approaches. Northern Ireland and much of Scotland will become steadily cloudier, with some rain in the Western Isles later.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Most areas dry on Monday, with sunny intervals by day, and patchy mist or low cloud overnight. However, patchy rain will affect northwestern parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland, perhaps some patchy drizzle in a few other areas. Tuesday will be generally dry with sunny spells, but rain affecting Scotland at first.
