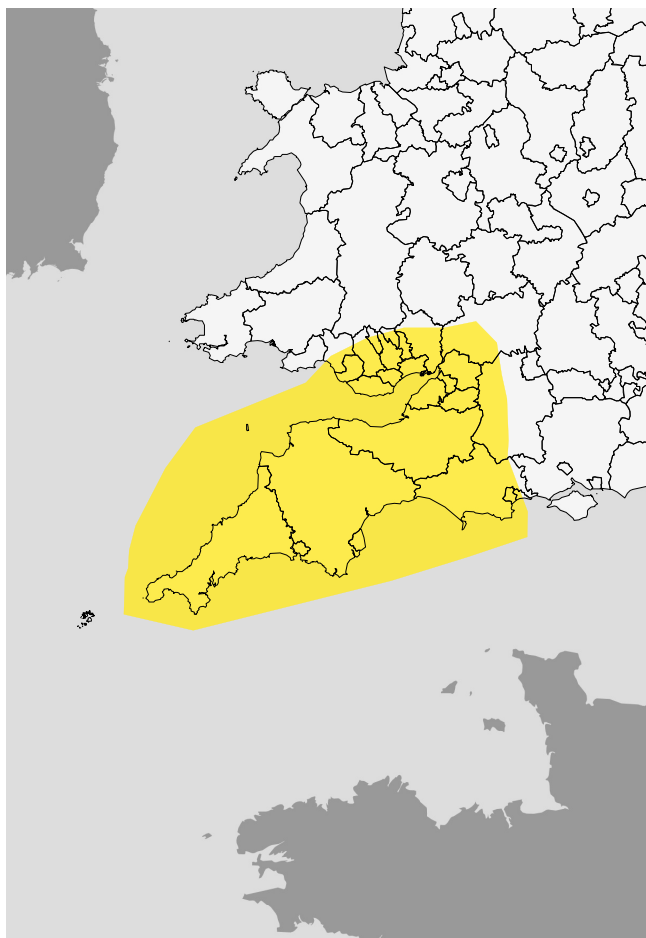


**Yellow warning

**Heavy rain is likely to affect southwest England and parts of south Wales.****What to expect**

- There is a small chance that homes and businesses could be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- There is a chance of delays or cancellations to train and bus services
- Spray and flooding could lead to difficult driving conditions and some road closures

Further details

Rain will spread northwards on Sunday and become heavy and persistent later in the day and overnight before easing from the south during Monday morning. 15-25 mm of rain is likely widely, with 40-50 mm locally.
