Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
A mixture of patchy cloud, bright spells and scattered showers is expected for much of the UK tomorrow. However, it should stay drier and brighter across Wales, Northern Ireland and southwest England. It will be a cold day though, with temperatures below normal, and breezy northeasterly winds.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It should be mainly dry with bright or sunny spells for England and Wales, but light rain is expected to spread across Scotland on Tuesday, reaching Northern Ireland by Wednesday. Temperatures will remain fairly cool, and winds should weaken slightly but remain from a northerly direction.
